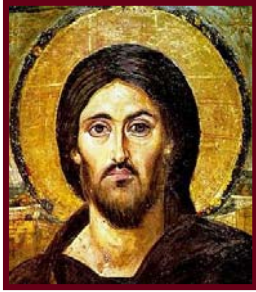

### **SUNDAY, OCTOBER 17 AT 4 PM — INSTALLATION OF THE DEAN OF THE CATHEDRAL**

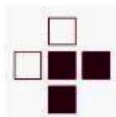
