Today's 10:00 a.m. Sunday morning Eucharist will be celebrated as a spoken Eucharist without choir, but with an opening and closing hymn. *Godly Play will take place as scheduled.* In commemoration of the **Feast of Candlemas**, you are invited to a joyful **Choral Eucharist at 4 p.m.** At Candlemas, the church remembers the infant Christ being presented in the Temple in Jerusalem to the old man Simeon who rejoices that, before he dies, he has seen this child, who will be 'a light to the nations'. Music for the Liturgy will include sacred choral works of Peter Maxwell Davies, Victor Kalinnikov, Zoltan Kodaly, Peter Phillips, Zachary Wadsworth sung by the Cathedral Singers under the direction to Tom Lloyd and accompanied by organist John Andrew Bailey.
